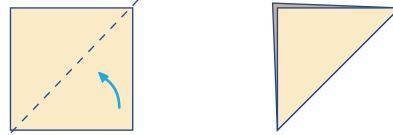


Make an Origami Bunny

Step 1

Fold a square piece of paper in half to make a triangle.



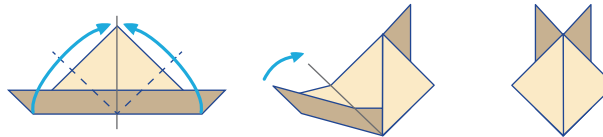
Step 2

Fold up the bottom of the triangle like in the picture.



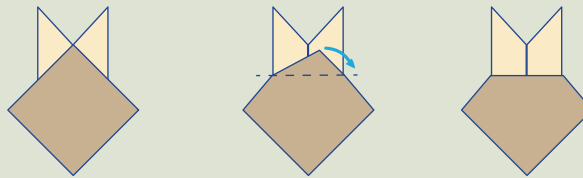
Step 3

Fold the 2 bottom corners to the top corner.



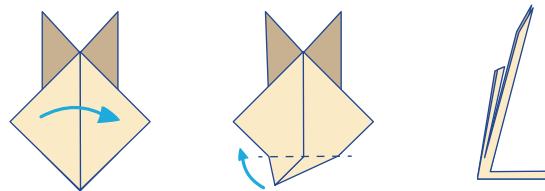
Step 4

Turn the paper over.
Fold the top corner of the square back and tuck it under.



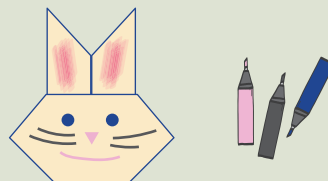
Step 5

Turn the paper over again.
Fold the bottom corner so the paper bunny can stand up.



Step 6

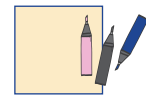
Draw eyes, nose, mouth and whiskers on the front. Colour the ears.



What You'll Need:

A square piece of paper for each person.

Coloured markers or pencils.



New Word:

Origami is the Japanese art of folding paper to make something.



More Origami Fun:

Look online to find other origami animals to make.

Try to fold a paper airplane. Test it out. How far can the paper airplane fly? Count your footsteps to see how far or use a measuring tape.

Let's Play

- Make up a story. Act out your story using your paper bunny.
- What pet would you like to have? Introduce your pet to the others. Pretend your paper bunny is that pet—maybe a horse or a kangaroo.
- Make up a play using all of the paper “pets.”
- How would each pet move? What sound would each pet make? Would they be cuddly? Would they be wild? Act out the play.
